INTERNATIONAL VALUATION STANDARDS (IVS) AGREEMENT

The undersigned applicant certifies that he or she is either (1) employed in the appraisal profession or (2) interested in becoming an appraiser. Applicant further agrees to take and pass the society’s examination in the Principles of Appraisal Practice and Code of Ethics within 10 months of the approval of his or her application for membership.

In addition, applicant agrees that (1) he or she does not currently engage in appraisal work in North America, (2) he or she has read and conducts his or her appraisal practice in accordance with the International Valuation Standards set forth by the International Valuation Standards Committee and (3) should there be a time in the future when he or she does conduct appraisal work within North America, it is his or her responsibility to inform ASA and complete an AQB-approved 15-hour Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) course and examination.

Applicant further agrees that at such a time in the future, should ASA develop a course and exam reflective of the IVS standards, he or she will be asked to take the course and pass the exam in order to maintain member status and must pass the exam every five years as part of ASA’s reaccreditation process.

ASA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS



MEMBERSHIP PACKAGE

Begin the process by submitting your membership package to ASA including:

- Completed/signed membership application
 - Résumé or qualifications statement
 - Three references
- Application fee, dues and optional journal subscription fee

Upon approval of your application (1–2 weeks), you will become an applicant.

APPLICANT

After membership approval, applicants have 10 months to:

- Pass the ASA Ethics exam (open book exam taken on ASA's Web site)
- Pass the 15-hour National Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) course and exam
 - Real Property applicants may provide their current state license in lieu of the 15-hour USPAP requirement.*
 - International applicants may submit the IVS waiver in lieu of taking the USPAP course if they meet the requirements to do so.*

Upon completion of these requirements, you will become a Candidate.

CANDIDATE

Candidates fall into one of two groups:

1. Those who are working toward meeting their discipline education requirements through Principles of Valuation (POV) courses or an education equivalency program
2. Those who have already met their discipline education requirements and are in the process of applying for a designation or are waiting to gain additional experience in order to meet the requirements for designation

Candidates who are ready to apply for a designation will need to pass their discipline's specialty/comprehensive exam (if applicable) and submit to ASA:

- Completed/signed accreditation application
 - Proof of education
 - Appraisal experience log
 - Appraisal report(s)
- Current USPAP certificate

Upon completion of these requirements, you will become either an Accredited Member or an Accredited Senior Appraiser.

ACCREDITED MEMBER

If you have 2–5 years of full-time appraisal experience, you will become an Accredited Member (AM) upon approval of your accreditation package.



ACCREDITED SENIOR APPRAISER

If you have 5 or more years of full-time appraisal experience, you will become an Accredited Senior Appraiser (ASA) upon approval of your accreditation package.

A Note on Recreditation:

All designated members of the American Society of Appraisers (ASA) are required to submit evidence of professional growth through continuing education and/or participation in professional activities every 5 years to remain an active AM, ASA or FASA. Our dedicated discipline-specific specialists are well-versed in ASA's recreditation policies and are available to answer your questions.
